### **Standing Reports:**

**Winter Guard Update** – Mr. Trobaugh replied that the plan to use the Middle School gym for practice has fallen through. Other possible locations are the band room and cafeteria. The ceiling height is the main factor. No purchases will be made, with the exception of flags, until a practice facility can be secured. Guard may be scrapped for this year if a facility cannot be found within the school system due to insurance purposes and other concerns. The search will continue for a practice location for the next few weeks. Keith Kutz made the motion to table the discussion until the next meeting. The motion was seconded. All were in favor, none opposed.

**Wing/Spring Fest** – Date has changed to April 5 and the option to do a spaghetti dinner with a silent auction & bake sale was brought up. Due to the lack of contact by the football organization, Mr. Bowers initiated all contact with the band boosters..
