

The Munford High School Band Boosters met on Monday, July 8th, 2013 in the Munford High School Band Room. President Larry Wildes brought the meeting to order at 7:11p.m, all executive officers were present.

Standing Reports:

Beginning with the secretary's report, Jennifer Kutz made a motion to dispense with the reading of the report because the minutes are available on the band website. The motion was seconded and passed. The treasurer's report was next and was read by Teresa Schelly. Tom Norwood made the motion to accept the report as read and none opposed. **The Treasurer's report is available for viewing by booster members upon request.**

A question was asked about the status of the year end audit and the reply was that the books are with the accountant and a report will be disclosed when completed.

Old Business:

Trailer/ Tent – The trailer may possibly be sand blasted for free by Mark Laxton of MPC Construction and paint will be purchased by the boosters at a substantial discount and will be spray painted at no charge. The white tent provided by Rent One has been approved by Dr. Fee and an email with the design was sent to Chip at Rent One.

July 4th Concessions - Thank you to all the volunteers for making it a success, \$1977.92 in profit was made. Funnel cakes were missed but required additional help.

Taekwondo Tournament – August 17th is the next concession fundraising opportunity at the high school (8am – 5). Anyone interested in helping contact Jen Kutz at concessions@munfordband.com.

Question was asked about the sale of Pepsi products and if it was required to start selling them. The answer was yes. The school has a contract with Pepsi and will receive a portion of sales on the bottled drinks and the band will receive their share of sales. Gatorade will stay.

Chaperone meeting will be held August 12, immediately following the booster meeting. Attendance is mandatory for anyone wishing to be a chaperone for any band competitions

or football games. Background checks are required and will be discussed in detail at the meeting.

Question was asked about Nike Band shirts. Chris Hacker replied that new Nike campaign will run again this year with a new design and with possibly more items available for sale. Items will be available for purchase during a two week period. More information on purchasing Nike gear will be available at a later date via fliers and email. Question about Nike sponsorship was asked. Nike does not make band uniforms and are not sponsoring bands for this reason. Nike is interested in making our show shirts and is currently working on a design. Chris Hacker creates the art work for band show shirts and asked if anyone would like to present any ideas they would be considered. Shirt and short sizes (S, M, L ect.) are still needed for show shirts and white shorts that are to be worn under uniforms. Extra show shirts will be available for purchase. Khaki shorts and show shirts will remain as the attire for blow out.

Estimated Budget – Larry Wildes presented the estimated budget for the 2013-2014 band season. **The estimated budget is available for viewing by booster members upon request.**

Medical Staff Remarks– Candi Wildes made a request for qualified medical staff volunteers. If you would like more information please contact Cathy Jarnagin at medical@munfordband.com. Please ask students to eat a healthy breakfast and not just “pop-tarts.” Breakfast and lunch is provided by the school and is equivalent to what they receive during the regular school year. Any band member that requires an EpiPen or Inhaler must have them on hand at all times band. In the event they do not, members will be required to call their parents to bring them or they will not be able to participate. 911 is only to be called in the event of an emergency by an administrator only, per Tipton County Board of Education rules. Students can leave for lunch as long as they have turned in a note with parent permission stating with whom and where they are going. Hydrate!!! Drink water!! No energy drinks period!! Water bottles and camelbacks are permitted. Water and Gatorade will be setup and ready by 7:15.

Question if the competition schedule is available yet. Schedule is not available yet but first competition is September 28th in Jackson.

Question about fittings for new uniforms was asked. Fittings will take place but not per the schedule released in the forms mailed. Fittings times will be announced.

Question was asked if the band will go to Nationals this year. Mr. Trobaugh replied with a definitive NO.

Question - Can the band use unsold football booster seats for band sponsors? Seats are already obligated to platinum band sponsors.

Motion was made by Sonya Lumpkin to purchase a three compartment stainless steel sink at an auction in Millington for the concession stand. An allotment was set at \$300 with a faucet and \$200 without a faucet. Motion was seconded by Heather Topping. All in favor none opposed. Motion passed. Annette Estes offered to purchase the sink in the event it did not fit.

Motion was made by Heather Topping to purchase roman column props for the show with a cap set at \$1000. Motion was seconded by Candi Wildes. All in favor and none opposed. Motion passed.

Director's Remarks:

Competition schedule will be 8wks long with the first event being held on September 28th. Southern States is the same day as Band Masters this year. Mini band camp will be held during fall break and a football game. There is not a completed formal schedule to date.

Question was asked if Band Camp Funding was adequate for staff. The answer was no, but it could be work out with staff.

A motion was made by Richard Keenan to increase the funding for the adjunct staff and band camp staff, by a total of \$3000. The motion was seconded by Heather Topping. Further discussion ensued with the outcome of Mr. Trobaugh requesting the total be lowered to \$2000 for band camp staff only at this time and to revisit increase adjunct staff funding at a later date.

A motion was then made by Mr. Keenan to amend the request for funds from \$3000 to a total of \$2000 for the summer band camp staff only and to revisit the increase in adjunct

staff pay at a later date. The motion was seconded by Heather Topping. All in favor none opposed. Motion passed.

Mr. Norwood made the motion to adjourn at 8:38pm, all were in favor.

Next booster meeting is August 12 at 6:30, chaperone meeting to follow immediately after.
