

MUNFORD BAND BOOSTER MEETING

The Munford High School Band Boosters met on Monday, July 14, 2014 in the Munford High School Band Room. President Chris Hacker brought the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m., all executive officers were present. Mr. Trobaugh was in attendance.

Standing Reports:

The secretary's report was first on the agenda. Christy Renfrow made the motion to dispense with the reading of the June 9, minutes as they are posted to the band website. The motion was seconded by Mary Frantz and passed with none opposed.

The treasurer's report was then read by Teresa Schelly and she stated the proposed format changes of the treasurer's report will appear on next month's agenda. A copy of the budget is available upon request to members of the Band Boosters only. Robert Li made the motion to accept the treasurer's report as read. The motion was seconded by Keith Kutz, none opposed. Motion passed.

Old Business:

An amendment was added to include an additional \$500 executive board emergency spending if needed. Motion was seconded by Gabriel Cantu. No further discussion. None opposed. Motion passed.

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Band students had a great day but there is always room for improvements. The medical staff was tested and put to good use on the first day. This year's show title is *From Eternal Winter* and is an adaptation of the movie *Frozen*. It portrays the battle between winter and spring.
