

The Munford High School Band Boosters met on **Monday, June 13, 2016** in the Munford High School Band room. President Ben Kirk brought the meeting to order at 7:11 p.m., VP D. Duncan, Treasurer C. Summers, Co-Treasurer, Secretary R. Keenan, & Band Director B. Trobaugh present. 34 members & 11 visitors in attendance.

**Standing Reports:**

Secretary's report: Minutes read by Secretary Rick Keenan. Tina McKinney made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Motion seconded by Clay Summers. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report: \$7700 due to Amro for instrument repairs. This amount could increase to \$8000. Mr. Trobaugh also needs another projector with an estimated cost of \$600. He also needs to purchase a new keyboard but a price is not yet available. We currently have enough money to pay off the uniform loan. Uniforms will not last as long as expected. Discussion was tabled concerning uniform loan tabled for new business. Tina McKinney made a motion to accept Treasurer's report as read. Motion seconded by Linda Norman. Motion carried.

**Old Business:**

Old concessions truck did sell for \$1500.

The new truck is being wrapped. It has been wrapped in white and is just waiting for the approval and application of graphics. Total cost of wrap will be \$2000 and a \$1000 sponsorship.

Uniform contribution discussion tabled from April was discussed. \$25 from the students' band fees usually go into the uniform account making the student contribution to the uniform account approximately \$5500. If we only decide to pay a portion of the loan instead of paying it off, we still have to make the monthly payments. Motion Dara Keeton to table the discussion until after new business. Motion seconded by Nellie Keeton. Motion carried.
