

The Munford High School Band Boosters met on Monday, September 9th, 2013 in the Munford High School Band Room. President Larry Wildes brought the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m., all executive officers were present. Mr. Trobaugh was not in attendance.

Standing Reports:

Beginning with the secretary's report, Keith Kutz made a motion to dispense with the reading of the report because the minutes are available on the band website. The motion was seconded by Scott Libby and passed.

Old Business:

Nike – Chris Hacker presented a sample of the player pack that consisted of a band camp survivor shirt, white shorts and a sling bag. The pack will be delivered as soon as the bag is shipped from Nike with the correct spelling. The Nike online store closed with modest sales compared to last year. A new online store can be opened on October 1st with different items with new artwork. Items suggested to add were shorts and sling bags. Delivery will be 3-4 weeks after order is placed. Reminder that for any items bought as Christmas gifts please contact Chris Hacker for pickup.

The treasurer's report was read by Teresa Schelly. A copy of the budget is available upon request to members of the Band Boosters only.

A question was asked about the amount spent to date on props. Vicki Disch responded that all of the receipts have not been turned in to accurately reflect the total amount spent but will be forthcoming.

Question was asked if the purchase of the second truck was still in the works. Larry Wildes responded that we are still looking for the best possible truck for the booster's money. He also spoke with Pepper Hazelrig and all that is necessary is to show a bill of sale and title. The trucks will then be registered with TCBOE for fuel and insurance.

Pam Ethridge made the motion to accept the treasurer's report as read, all were in favor and none opposed.

Call from Mayor Cole came in concerning a grant that was applied for in July to help pay for band uniforms. The Munford Celebrate committee will be presenting a check to the Munford Band on September 21st.

Co-Treasurer Stephanie Van Der Linden discussed the issues with the Charms website. She said that they are working on it but it is out of the Band Boosters' control. If anyone needs their Charms account # or any other information regarding Charms, please contact Stephanie Van Der Linden.

Question asked – What is Charms? It is an account for parents to view your student band fee balance. (The funds that are taken in for your child's band fees, shoes, pants and gloves either through direct payment or through fundraising)

Schedule –The band will not be going to Dyer County on September 20th due to the choir performance and there will be NO practice that night. The band will go to the Brighton football game as a show of support but may not perform due to their homecoming activities. First competition is September 28.

Official communication will not be posted on Facebook. It will come via email from Munford Band Communications.

First performance in uniform will be homecoming night September 27th. Workpants need to be ready and hemmed by then. If workpants did not fit see Jamie Miller.

Question was asked about taking the bleacher pads to various competitions. It is not practical due to size and the fact that the kids do not sit during most events.

A request to provide more information on the addresses and directions to competitions was made.

Celebrate – Band is to meet tentatively at Poplar Park at 2p.m. for practice, performance is at 4pm.

Concessions help was requested for Munford Celebrate and a signup sheet was passed around. If you can help between 6a.m. and 5p.m. and have not been contacted, please contact Jen Kutz. Band kids are welcome to help.

New Business:

Ice Machine – The purchase of a Maxx Ice machine that will produce 460 pounds of ice per day was brought up, at the cost of \$2450. A discussion ensued over the details of the size, shipping, and requirements to connect the ice machine.

Jen Kutz made the motion to spend up to \$2500 on the purchase of a new ice machine and was seconded by Scott Libby. All were in favor, none opposed. Motion Passed.

Band Fees – Next payment is due September 15. Charms will automatically deduct any fundraising monies from band fees.

Question asked -- Can Charms money be used for the spring trip? – Yes.

Jackson/ Arlington (September 28) – Boxed lunch from Lenny's will be provided by the booster's and will be delivered to Christ Church. Lunch for the chaperones will be provided as well.

No performance times as of yet on any competitions.
Considering stopping at Golden Corral after Cookeville and kids will need to bring \$10 for their meal.

Gibson and West Memphis – October 5 & 12 kids will need money for concessions these days but snacks and a drinks will be provided by the boosters. Kids are encouraged to bring extra snacks but **No cheesy snacks or gum. Also, bring twist top drinks only.**

Denise Dillon had brief remarks concerning popcorn delivery. The Coupon books fundraiser is due September 17th, and will be in within a week after the order is placed.

A fall break mini band camp will be held on Friday, October 18th from 8 a.m.-3p.m.
